Using Zoom

Zoom is a computer application that allows groups of individuals to interact with each other remotely. We will be using it for our online services. Even if you have limited experience with using computers following this guide will help you to join us.

What you need

-A computer with an internet connection or a smart phone. -The Zoom Application (app). Also called Zoom client.

Also helpful: -

-A Video or Web Camera (most modern devices have this built in). If you don't have a camera then you will be able to see others but they will be unable to see you.

-A microphone if you are using a computer. Again, most modern computers will have a microphone built in. If you don't have a microphone, others will not be able to hear you.

How to get the Zoom Application

Go to <u>https://zoom.us/download</u> and click the blue "download" rectangle under the title "zoom client for meeting" and follow the installation instructions.

When you have done this you should see the zoom icon on your computer or smart phone.

How to join an online service

Open the zoom application by double-clicking on a computer or selecting on your phone.

Click / Select "Join Meeting"

You now have to enter some information.

Firstly, the **zoom meeting ID**. This is like a phone number to the host of the meeting. You can find this on our online schedule (page 2 of Church at Home)

Secondly, you will need to type in our **password**. This is currently **"Paul".** You will now be given some options such as if you want to join the meeting with your camera (if you wish to be seen by others) or without (if you just want to observe the service).

- Choose 3 members to light the 3 candles (engage all ages)

Opening words of praise with lighting of 3 candles -

I will light a light in the name of the Maker, who lit the world and gave everything life.

I will light a light in the name of the Son, who saved the world and stretched out his hand to me.

I will light a light in the name of the Spirit, who is present everywhere in the world and gives me strength.

Together: We will light three lights for the trinity of love: God above us, God beside us, God beneath us; The beginning, The end and the Everlasting one.

Are you good at doing something or have a particular skill you need your hands for? There may be things that you do not like doing that you need to use your hands for!!

Bible passage: Mark 1.29-39

Read through together and share is there is something that you did not know or realise in the story before.

Jesus was using this time to show and demonstrate God's power and what a life in the Kingdom of God looked like. He was showing that in God's Kingdom there was forgiveness, healing, truth and power and that it also restores people back into the community. God calls us into service (to work for him) within our communities, even Jesus struggled at first to find his purpose, but he knew by praying and spending time with God he would find the answer. Go back to your hands and think once again of how you use your hands, is there something you can do using your hands that brings forgiveness, heals, brings, truth, or power – is there something that you can do that helps to restore people back into your community?

Interactive Learning......

Minute to Win it Games.....

After you have played several together, share about how you felt about the challenge of that game, we are all challenged and to called to serve God, called to community, we are also called sometimes into the challenges that seem daunting and unachievable - but it is here that we meet God, and sometimes our fears, face to face. It is in the challenge and daunting times that we find our purpose and learn to trust completely in God's will.

Create a Sacred Space.....

Designate a special prayer space in your home. You can use a small table, a corner, or a bookshelf. Gather objects and/or pictures to place in your sacred (prayer) space. For instance, a piece of green fabric, a cross or crucifix, a light representing Jesus light in us - use LED candles, a favourite lamp or a torch. You might want to add objects such as seashells, rocks, plants and flowers to show the beauty of God's Creation. The colours of your fabric can change with different times of the liturgical (church) year. E.g., White cloth as the Easter season arrives. A Family prayer jar can also be added with pictures of your family reminding you to be thankful for them and a reminder to prav for them.

It's important to remember this is your sacred (special) place, a place where you can switch off from everything else and a space where you invest in your relationship with Jesus. Although Jesus travelled, taught and healed people he still needed time and space to pray to God, he needed to be in God's presence before continuing his ministry.



Prayer Picture.....

Take a walk together around your local community, take pictures of places where you feel God is calling (asking) you to pray. It could be your school, the local shops & workers, or park. When home create a prayer picture & use this collage in your prayers this week. Thank God for them and pray for healing & restoration.

Hand Printing.....

Create different hand patterns by painting your hands and making handprints on paper. Around the printing of your hands write one or two sentences from the bible reading. These could be made into other shapes too.



Paper Weaving.....

On strips of 3 different colored paper write Be changed. Be transformed. Keep following. Use these strips to weave in an out of A4 sheet with straight cuts in it as in the diagrams below. As you weave reflect on the 3 statements. (changed, transformed, following)

Whilst creating chat about the following questions & Share stories..... I wonder is there a connection between praying and healing....... Where could you create a space to pray? – this could be your sacred space I wonder what Jesus prayed for.....

Reflection & Prayer Time.....

On paper hearts name those who you know are unwell and needs God's Love & Healing. Use these to pray for these people and lift before God.

Gather.....

- Choose 3 members to light the 3 candles (engage all ages)

Opening words of praise with lighting of 3 candles -

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Welcome.....

Song: What a Beautiful Name It Is https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=r5L6QIAH3L4 (can be sung or listened to)

Reflection time: Preparation – write the word Transfiguration on a piece of paper. Try and see how many new words you can make from its letters. Explain that it means being transformed into something more beautiful.

Bible passage: Read Together Mark 9:2-8 and/or watch

Read from different translations and bibles translated for different age ranges.

Ask your family to listen to the Bible reading again, this time with their eyes closed. Help them imagine climbing a mountain, hot and dry, going slowly where it gets steep, catching your breath as the climb gets harder. Then standing with Peter, James and John watching as Jesus, your friend, who you thought you knew, changing right in front of your eyes.

Keep that picture in your mind as you hear that voice, the voice of God claiming Jesus as His Own Son. That is God, the creator of the universe speaking. Listen to that voice, what is it saying to you? Let that voice help you trust, and follow Jesus more closely as you see Jesus, the Son of God, being transfigured in front of you.

God changes us too as we journey with Jesus, if we let Him. Then others will see that we have the love of Jesus in our heart by seeing his reflection shining brightly within us!

Interactive Learning.....

All Change

Resources: old, dirty coins (preferably one each, a plastic container with a lid, 1 heaped tablespoon of salt and half a cup of vinegar (mixed and put into the lidded container), a container holding water, a container to hold the used salt/ vinegar mix.

Discuss how our lives sometimes are a bit like the coin, dirtied up by the wrong things we do that we wish we hadn't. Explain that, if we ask Jesus to help us, He can help us to become more like him and take away the dirt.

He can change our lives.

Asked everyone to put their coins into the vinegar and salt mixture, close the lid and shake the box. As soon as the coins go into the mix they start to change!

Empty away the salt/ vinegar and put the coins into water. They are now very shiny!



Clouds

Bring the story to life by making a "fizzy float". Put 3 spoonful's of ice-cream (one each for Jesus, Moses and Elijah) into a cup and pour something fizzy over the top to create a "cloud".



Valentine Tree !

Today is also St Valentines day when thoughts turn to love. Make a 'love' ly tree by drawing around someone's arm and hand. Then add hearts as leaves. They can be in paint, pens, outlines, cut from magazines or paperanything.

As you add a heart write the name of someone loved by God – start with your family and then add as many others as you can. Pray for them that they would know the love God has for them especially at this tricky time.



Still Changing....

Think about the ways you want to change to be more like Jesus, maybe you need to think of others more? Maybe sharing is hard? As you hold your shiny coin ask God to help you change so you look more like Jesus.

Whilst creating chat about the following questions & share stories....

- I wonder how Peter, James and John felt when Jesus asked them to go for a walk with him...
- I wonder what it was like climbing the mountain...
- I wonder what they could see from the top...
- I wonder what Peter, James and John thought when they saw Moses and Elijah.

Reflection & Prayer Time.....




